

Togo | 13–24 February



From February 13–24, a Harvest MxD team will be traveling to Togo, a nation that has been on our hearts for some time. This is not a sudden decision. We have waited, prayed, and trusted Holy Spirit for the right timing. And that time has now come!



This trip marks a major milestone. Our first *Basic Discipleship Training* manual was translated into French, and the materials have already begun to be used in Togo. With the manual now available in French, it can also be used in neighboring nations such as Benin, extending the impact well beyond this single trip!

Togo has five administrative regions. The team will minister in four of them. By the end, over 500 ministers and lay leaders will be trained to use these discipleship materials in their churches and villages. We anticipate strengthened churches and new church plants emerging from the training as leaders are equipped and sent.

Our focus remains clear: villages, rural areas, and faithful leaders who rarely receive training or resourcing. We are convinced lasting cultural transformation begins in the villages, where faith is lived daily and the Gospel takes deep root.


To maximize impact, the team will travel together and then split into smaller teams within each region. This allows for broader reach while maintaining unity & personal investment. Our heart is to raise up Believers rooted & grounded in the Word, who will replicate themselves... *working together toward the Great Completion!*

A Very Personal Family Update

We also want to share a personal update from the Böhmer family. Villy's sister, Vilna, has taken in another foster child, making this the second child she is currently fostering. This precious baby, often referred to as a “*throwaway baby*,” was born to a 13-year-old girl connected to the Rescue Centre.

Her name is Xoshiwe Warona Talientjie. We will not even attempt to provide the pronunciation of Xoshiwe (since it's a Xhosa name with "clicks" American mouths weren't designed for!), but Talientjie is pronounced *tah-lean-key*, and that is the name she is lovingly called. Together, her names mean: "*they threw her away, but now she is ours.*"

This small life reminds us why village-focused discipleship matters. It is not abstract. It shapes real lives, families, and futures. Sometimes, the quiet rescue of one child tells the whole story.



Provision, Prayer, and Stewardship

A major portion of this trip has already been covered, and it continues to leave us in awe. It is a true testimony of God's goodness and provision! Pappa Böhmer and Bishop Emmanuel's travel have been covered in full, and much of the groundwork is already in place. At this stage, we are trusting God for Villy's travel expenses, totaling approximately \$2,500.

And if we're being honest for a moment... Villy would love to be part of this trip. This African of mine truly comes alive when his feet touch African soil. That said, it's not only Africa. Villy was created for the nations and carries a grace for cross-cultural ministry.
