Why a Rescue Centre?

Last month, our Rescue Centre—which exists to *rescue children from crisis and give them a safe place to belong*—faced something no one ever wants... **a fire**.

Late one night, two or three little boys—just 5 to 8 years old—showed up at our door looking for shelter. They couldn't stay at home because of severe drug and alcohol abuse in their families. This is exactly why our Rescue Centre exists—to be a place where *children can find safety, hope, and a new beginning when there's nowhere else to go*.

A Candle, a Fire, and God's Protection



When the boys arrived, they found the community room unlocked. With rolling blackouts in South Africa, they lit a candle for warmth and light. Exhausted, they eventually fell asleep—but the candle was too close to the curtains.

And the curtains caught fire...

By God's grace, the boys were unharmed, and the building itself is still standing. But the fire destroyed furniture, caused heavy, smoke damage that now needs repainting, and damaged part of the roof that must be repaired.

- Replace burned furniture
