

HIDDEN PLACES. HOLY ASSIGNMENTS.

A Word Fulfilled in Plain Sight

Several years ago, God spoke to Villy about a *coming move of His Spirit* in the “**small**” and “**obscure**” places, regions often overlooked, places that seem insignificant in the natural yet are the very ground where an awakening would begin. Not a revival of the past, but something new.

Over the last two months, we’ve watched that word unfold. Everywhere we’ve gone, the message was the same: God is awakening hunger in the hidden places, and what He whispered long ago is now happening.

AFRICAN-STYLE PRAYER TRIP: Obedience on the I-40 Corridor

When Villy’s long-time friend and ministry companion, Chris Crane, shared he sensed the Lord calling them to take an African-style missions trip right here in the good ol’ USA, they loaded up, pointed towards the I-40 corridor, and prayed simply: “*Lord, wherever You open a door... we’ll go.*”

Off they went! No schedule. No platform. No agenda. Only obedience and prayer. Their mission? Strengthening pastors, blessing families, and igniting Kingdom fire across America!

From the Big Texan in Amarillo to churches across Oklahoma, the pattern was the same: open doors, churches hungry for Him, communities ready for fresh fire, and Holy Spirit moving in unexpected places. It wasn’t flashy but powerful. Every stop confirmed that Holy Spirit is stirring in “small” places.

Deep in the hills of Appalachia, they met Sheldon Livesay and *Of One Accord Ministry*... where Kingdom work thrives and humility leads, faithfully stewarding resources, protecting families, & working with churches to meet real needs. It affirmed that God’s greatest works often grow in places overlooked by man.

In Louisville, KY, a simple lunch became a divine appointment: a restaurant owner marked by radical generosity and a moment orchestrated by Heaven, reminding them that *God still interrupts ordinary spaces with extraordinary grace when His people pray, listen, and obey.*

This journey wasn’t about miles or meetings. It was about following Holy Spirit’s leading, step by step, stop by stop. With every mile, the word God gave Villy years ago came into even sharper focus: an awakening *is* beginning in unlikely places and the soil *is* ready!



PINE RIDGE – The Echo of that Word

The first week of November, Villy and his father, Papa Böhmer, had the honour of ministering on the Pine Ridge Reservation alongside our amazing friend Josh Yazzie, a Navajo missionary to the Lakota people.
