Hello, Friends! What an incredible God-adventure! On 17 July, Villy and our friends, Chris Crane & Lance Milford, set off for Zambia with hearts full of expectation... And God moved in ways *way beyond* anything we even imagined!

Hungry Hearts Everywhere!

Ministry took place in the surrounding villages of Kitwe, Zambia—and the response was overwhelming! Pastors pleaded with us to stay longer, saying no one had ever come into their villages to do conferences like this before.

In a mining town, we thought pastors might slip in between shifts... but hunger for the Word was so great, many took 2 full days off to attend! Holy Spirit moved mightily as Papa Böhmer, Lance, and Bishop Friday Lunda ministered, bringing refreshing and renewal. In Kalulushi, Villy, Bishop Emmanuel, and his son, Rev. Chisa, led the gatherings, encouraging pastors to equip their congregations to do the work of the ministry.

God's Strength in Our Weakness

From there, we travelled to Lusaka for a 2-day conference with ministry friend, Andrew Mwaba. Again, God showed up powerfully! After two full weeks of non-stop ministry, we thought we were finished—tired, exhausted, ready to rest—when we learned there was *“just one more”* church wanting us to come. That “quick greeting” turned into another full ministry service. But God poured out the exact strength we needed for just one more service!

Zambia was nothing short of a move of God—marked by deep joy, new friendships, the fire of Holy Spirit, & unforgettable moments in His presence. We cannot wait to return within the next year to pour into more villages across Zambia with the life-changing Good News of Jesus Christ, raising up Believers to be disciplined and to make disciples!

One pastor's testimony still moves us deeply: he walked over 40 km each day—yes, on foot!—just to be a part of what God was doing! Leaving home at 4 AM, he arrived around 11 AM. He vowed to take Harvest MxD discipleship material back to his own village and train others. Stories like his are why our hearts *burn* for the villages—this is where hunger for God's Word is so raw, so real, & so ready!

Thanks to the generosity of our partners, we printed over 1,000 copies of our Year One Harvest MxD curriculum! This is not *“just another book”*—we desire it to be a **living tool** in the hands of Believers to get *rooted and grounded in the Word* and *trained as laborers* for the Harvest!

At the same time, Chris boldly shared the Gospel in village marketplaces—pressing on, even while sick—in over six locations around Kitwe in evangelism outreaches. Souls were reached, hearts were touched, and Heaven rejoiced!

They also visited the Rescue Centre, and on their final Sunday before returning to the U.S., Villy had the joy of dedicating a precious 2-week-old baby, whose mother—only 13 years old—is one of the young girls finding refuge there.



The Rescue Centre is still recovering from fire damage, which destroyed the electricity supply. Without power, there's no running water or heat—critical in the current winter months. But, because of your generosity, we believe restoration is coming soon!

From the Heart of Zambia:

A Message from Bishop Emmanuel

MISSIONS WEEK

Harvest MxD Ministries, launched February 2025 in Kitwe, Zambia, returned in July for its first major missions program. From 19-28 July, anointed teachings and powerful ministry were delivered across Kitwe, Mufulira, Kalulushi, Chibuluma, and Lusaka.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

On Sunday, 20 July, the mission began with impactful sermons across multiple churches. Several congregations were deeply moved as Papa Böhmer, Villy Böhmer, Chris Crane, and Lance Milford, ministered in different locations.

That afternoon, Discipleship Training Programs commenced in Mufulira, Chibuluma, and Kitwe's market areas. In Mufulira, Papa Böhmer and Lance Milford trained around 500 pastors and leaders, including 15 bishops. In Chibuluma, Pastor Villy led 150–200 leaders over three days, while Pastor Lance shared profound revelation on Christ from Old to New Testament. Meanwhile, Pastor Chris preached in Kitwe's busy markets, where hundreds came to Christ and many were healed and delivered.

In Mufulira, Pastor Villy was affectionately nicknamed "Church Government." His surname sounded like "BOMA," once an acronym for *British Overseas Municipality Administration*. Each time his name was mentioned, leaders said *"the Government is speaking."* It became a prophetic symbol of the authority and weight of the Word being preached.

In Chibuluma, a pastor declared: ***"From now on, the church will be known by its sending, rather than by the people it keeps in the church."*** This statement was received with loud cheers and celebration, marking a shift in vision for many leaders. The training programs concluded with the issuing of certificates of attendance, joy and thanksgiving overflowed.

TESTIMONIES

In Chibuluma, Pastor Mulenga testified that Harvest MxD brought fresh insights and direction for ministry. Pastor Moyo, emphasized that ***the unity now seen among the clergy is a direct result of Harvest MxD's ministry***, something never before experienced in Chibuluma. He added that the revelations sparked fresh passion for service, and pastors requested longer sessions in the future.

In Mufulira, the impact continues. At a church where Pastor Lance preached, at least 25 new people have been attending every Sunday since. Young pastors and self-proclaimed “prophets” who previously lacked mentorship are now submitting to discipleship under Pastor Friday Lunda. Above all, the remarkable unity that Harvest MxD brought among clergy—across towns, fellowships, and denominations—was one of the greatest testimonies of this mission. Leaders repeatedly declared that such oneness of heart had not been seen before.

CONCLUSION

The revival that has begun in Kitwe, Kalulushi, Chibuluma, Mufulira, and Lusaka has set a strong foundation for the future. Leaders and churches have been empowered, unity has been strengthened, and the Gospel of our Lord Jesus has been boldly proclaimed. Truly, this was a transformative week for Zambia, and we thank God for the grace He has placed on Harvest MxD Foundation to disciple nations.
